## *Workshop 3.2 Overview*

### **W3.2: eConsent in clinical trials**

*UK Trial Managers' Network, Trials Methodology Research Partnership, UKCRC CTU Network Collaborative Group*

Recording consent for clinical trial participation is a fundamental part of Good Clinical Practice. Increasing, electronic methods (e-consent) for recording consent are being used. E-consent use increased out of necessity during the Covid-19 pandemic, however despite encouragement from the Health Research Authority (HRA) and Medicines for Health Regulatory Agency (MHRA), there is little implementable, on-the-ground guidance on use of eConsent.

In this workshop, we aim to share examples of implementation of eConsent, discuss methods that are being used across the UK and, in groups, share best practices and challenges in implementing eConsent. We will also discuss potential areas for methodology research. We envisage the workshop being highly interactive, with participants learning from one another, and encourage people to be vocal!

The workshop will build upon a previous online, national workshop held in January 2022, which was also run by members of the UK Trial Managers' Network, the TMRP trial conduct and health informatic working groups and the UKCRC registered Clinical Trials Unit Network.

Anyone who has used eConsent or is considering using eConsent methods in the future could benefit from attending this workshop, including trial managers, data managers, methodologists and programmers.
